



How the Saints/Believers show brotherly love to each other:

- 1 Thessalonians 4:9 But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to **love one another**.

How believers show brotherly love to each other:

- 1) Pray for each other
- 2) Talk to the brothers & sisters in the Lord – Don't shun a brother/sister in the Lord
- 3) We are "with them".... In CHURCH; where are my brothers & sisters?
- 4) I prefer them over other people: **that does NOT mean you do NOT love the lost!** You want to (and prefer to) hang out with the brethren!
- 5) I am concerned about them!
- 6) I sacrifice my own time for the brethren **from time to time**
- 7) They can inconvenience me without my being disgruntled! (Meekness, willing to be taken advantage of, willing to be inconvenienced)
- 8) I put with their personal annoying idiosyncrasies
- 9) I gently encourage them instead of condemning them when they do an unusual wrong
- 10) Firm in my opposition to their plans to do wrong (show them that it is not pleasing to the Lord!)
- 11) Seek to include them within my acquaintances

- 1 John 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.
- John 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another
- John 15:12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.
- Romans 12:10 Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another
- Ephesians 4:2 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;
- 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:
- 1 John 4:11 – 12
 - 11** Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.
 - 12** No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and His love is perfected in us.
- 2 John 1:5 And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another.
